New Uniforms

Yes, it is true! There is a significant change to the clothing that Patriotic Degree Sir Knights will wear to 4th Degree functions. We are in the process of changing over to a new **Fourth Degree uniform** that will be taking the place of the Regalia/Full Regalia we currently wear. No doubt the decision to adopt a new uniform came as a surprise to the majority of us when it was announced at the National Convention by Supreme representatives – only the Provincial Vice-Supreme Masters and above were in on the change and the reasons behind it.

The uniform changeover will occur between now and June 30, 2018 and it's a "done deal." There has been a lot of venting about the change but all the #KeepOurRegalia and SaveOurRegalia online petitions will be for naught.

I'll be attending the John H. Reddin Provincial meeting in Salt Lake City Sept. 15-16 where there will be a lot of guidance and updated information presented concerning the new uniform and I will be getting the word out through you FNs and DMs and also update my District Marshals tasks and Duties memo with the latest.

Meanwhile, here are key points regarding the new uniform:

- Uniform components: blue blazer w/ 4th Degree crest, gray trousers, 4th degree necktie, beret w/4th emblem, 4th Degree pin. Plain collar, long-sleeve white shirt, black shoes and sox provided by the member. Uniform components must be purchased from K of C *Knights Gear* online store. Base price is \$510 for all components; individual components will not be sold separately at this time. Know your clothing sizes and measure carefully when ordering components through *Knights Gear*. Order before September 30, 2017 and you will receive a 25% discount.
- Initial delivery of new Fourth Degree uniforms for District Masters should occur the first week of September. Next batch of orders will not be delivered until mid to late November.
- Color patches denoting Fourth Degree officer positions (SM, VSM, MFD, DM, FN, CCC) will be worn behind emblem on beret. Patches cannot be ordered with basic uniform; they will be provided through me once Supreme figures out the logistics. For Knights of Columbus
- Retain your **service** baldric, sword and scabbard, white gloves as they will be part of the Fourth Degree color corps uniform. Note that these items can only be purchased through *Lynch & Kelly* or *The English Company*.
- Effective August 4, 2017, the official dress for a current Sir Knight or new SK candidate is a black, navy blue or dark gray **suit** worn with a plain white shirt, long necktie (color not specified), black shoes and sox and a Fourth Degree lapel pin (no **social** baldric is worn).

Voluntarily purchasing and wearing the official Fourth Degree uniform as described above will qualify you to be a color corps member and be part of honor guards and color guards.

District Marshals and Faithful Navigators will be expected to acquire the new Fourth Degree uniform in order to hold office.

There is no longer a requirement to acquire a tuxedo although Sir Knights who have Regalia/Full Regalia may still wear these items to Patriotic functions and formations until June 30, 2018.

Rosary Rally and Blue Mass

For those Sir Knights proud and honored to wear their Full Regalia in the remaining months that it's authorized, mark your calendars so you can participate in the annual Archdiocese of Santa Fe's Rosary Rally and Mass at Isotope's Park in Albuquerque on Sunday, October 1st starting at 2:00 p.m.

Here is an opportunity to participate in what could be one of the last and possibly largest honor guards wearing our soon-to-be retired colorful capes and chapeaus here in New Mexico.

In addition, the 10th annual Blue Mass hosted by the Archdiocese of Santa Fe will take place at St. Jude Thaddeus Parish on **Thursday, December 7th starting at 12:00 p.m.** One more limited opportunity to wear the traditional Full Regalia and participate in an honor guard.

THE NEW FOURTH DEGREE UNIFORM

8/14/2017

The Knights of Columbus board of directors unanimously voted to adopt a new uniform for the Fourth Degree. The decision was made with the good of the entire Order in mind. While we understand that some members may prefer the old regalia, the supreme master and vice supreme masters urge all Fourth Degree members to put the good of the Order before any personal preference.

The board decided to make this move based on the following factors: the aging of our Fourth Degree membership, the slow growth of the Fourth Degree (fewer than 20 percent of Knights are Fourth Degree members, and only a fraction of that number even serve as honor guards) consistent reports that the old regalia presented a barrier to Fourth Degree membership, especially among younger men



The following FAQ should answer many of the questions that have arisen concerning this change.

Q: Will the new uniform allow the use of ceremonial swords?

A: Yes. Ceremonial swords will continue to be part of the Fourth Degree. When swords are used, gloves should also be used. (see picture above).

Q: How will rank be distinguished?

A: Colored patches will be worn on the beret behind the Fourth Degree emblem as follows:

Dark Blue Supreme Master Light Blue Vice Supreme Masters Gold District Masters White Faithful Navigators Green District Marshals Purple Color Corp Commanders

Those not holding office (who formerly wore red capes) will wear berets with no patch.

Q: Where can I buy the new uniform?

A: www.knightsgear.com

Q: Will there be discounts offered on the new uniform?

A: Yes. The Order will subsidize the new uniform with a 25 percent discount offered to all members who order the new uniform prior to Sept. 30, 2017.

Q: What if a member just purchased the old regalia?

A: Any member who purchased the old regalia after May 1, 2017, can submit their receipt along with their member number to **regaliacredit@kofc.org**. Information will then be sent to that member on how to receive a \$200 credit toward the new uniform.

Q: Is the Order making money on the new uniform?

A: No, the uniform is being sold at (or sometimes below) our cost.

Q: Was the new uniform field tested prior to its release?

A: Yes. The new uniform was field tested by Fourth Degree members attending the Warriors to Lourdes pilgrimage.

Q: Can the old regalia still be worn?

A: Yes, for a time. While the preference is for the new uniform wherever possible, the old regalia can still be worn until the end of the current fraternal year (June 30, 2018). After that date, only the new uniform should be worn.

Q: Who made this decision?

A: The board of directors made this decision earlier this year after a three year period of testing and discussion. In addition, changing the uniform/regalia was previously discussed with the vice supreme masters at the Supreme Assembly.

Q: Did members have input on this?

A: For years, supreme officers and directors have received comments from members and prospective members that the old regalia was a barrier to membership overall, or to membership in the Fourth Degree.

Q: In what context should this change best be understood?

A: During the convention, the Good of the Order Committee stated: "We commend all of the faithful Sir Knights who have proudly worn the Fourth Degree regalia, bringing much respect to the Order. With the new Fourth Degree uniform, recently approved by the Board of Directors, this honor and respect associated with Sir Knights will remain, and it will open the door more widely for a new generation to join their ranks. In a spirit of unity, let us assist with a smooth transition to this new uniform and encourage it to be worn with great dignity and pride."

Your life of love and labor for souls was sacrificed amid the horrors of a concentration camp and hastened to its end by an injection of a deadly drug.





"Human life is sacred and inviolable at every moment of existence, including the initial phase which precedes birth. All human beings, from their mother's womb, belong to God who searches them and knows them, who forms them and knits them together with his own hands, who gazes on them when they are tiny shapeless embryos and already sees in them the adults of tomorrow whose days are numbered and whose vocation is even now written in the 'book of life.' There too, when they are still in their mothers' womb—as many passages of the Bible bear witness—they are the personal objects of God's loving and fatherly providence." (Evangelium Vitae, 61).

In his 1995 Encyclical, Evangelium Vitae, St. John Paul II called on all Catholic faithful to bear witness to the Gospel of Life and to build the "civilization of life and love" (100). In keeping with this mission and our Order's Catholic principles of charity, unity, and fraternity, the Knights of Columbus stands strong in its conviction that every human life is a gift of God, endowed with certain inalienable rights — the first among these being the right to life. Even in the midst of difficulties and uncertainties, we believe that human life is sacred and inviolable, and ought to be defended with maximum determination. To this end, the Knights of Columbus supports policies that promote a Culture of Life and opposes legislative efforts that promote abortion, contraception, sterilization, cloning, the destruction of embryos, assisted suicide, euthanasia, unjust war, and the death penalty when there is an acceptable alternative.

One of the most effective ways in which the Knights of Columbus has promoted a Culture of Life and helped thousands of women save their children is through the Ultrasound Initiative. From Brother Curt Kuper, Project Defending Life



Friends for Life,

We have some very exciting news! Project Defending Life and Coalition for Life NM are moving forward on securing a building! This location would hopefully house our chapel and the Coalition's headquarters where they will operate and manage 40 Days for Life, Sidewalk Advocates for Life, and the HUB of NM Radio. And the best part? This building is at 729 San Mateo Blvd, less than a block north of our previous, long-time location. Based on our survey we sent out a couple weeks ago, we could see how important it is to us and our donors that we have a chapel as close as possible to an abortion clinic. Our chaplain, Fr. Daniel, CFR, is meeting with Archbishop Wester this month to ask permission to consecrate a new chapel. Please pray we get the approval!

Because of this change, we will have to update our hours of operations. First of all, we will be closed at our Prospect Ave office the whole week of September 4. Starting September 11, our new hours are as follows:

Monday: Closed

Tuesday: 10 am to 3 pm Wednesday: 10 am to 3 pm Thursday: 10 am to 3 pm

Friday: Closed

Once everything is finalized and ready to go with the San Mateo building, we will send out updates on hours of operation for that location.

40 Days for Life starts on Wednesday September 27th and this time it will be held at the late term abortion mill in Albuquerque, the Planned Parenthood in Santa Fe, the Planned Parenthood in Farmington (which was kept open by pro-abortion donations), the abortion mill in Santa Teresa NM (close to Las Cruces), and again at Planned Parenthood's abortion mill in Albuquerque.

Lives have been saved each time 40 Days for Life has been held - over 13,000 at all the locations in the US and in a few other countries. Many more children's lives can be saved when you and your fellow church-members come out to pray this Fall.

Please help spread the word about 40 Days for Life at your church, parish, and religious group. Share the attached flyer, ask for permission to post it on the church bulletin board, include it in the church bulletin, and email it to your friends. Bring a friend when you come out to pray for the children in the womb and their moms. Join the sidewalk counselors that are there in the morning on abortion days - they will greatly appreciate having prayer partners, which often results in lives being saved.

Father Artur leads a prayer group at 9 AM on Friday mornings at the Planned Parenthood on San Mateo and sidewalk counselors are there from 8-11 AM on Tuesday's and Friday's. Philip leads a Rosary at the late term abortion mill at 9 AM on Wednesday mornings and sidewalk counselors are there on Wednesday's and Thursday's from 7-11 AM.


